

AKRON AREA YMCA COVID-19 ISOLATION & QUARANTINE

INTRODUCTION

The Akron Area YMCA is diligently tracking essential trends and information provided by the CDC, the Ohio Department of Health, and our local county health departments.



POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULTS

Regardless of Symptoms or Vaccination Status:

- Isolation from work for 5 days from the onset of symptoms or 5 days from the date the positive test sample was taken if no symptoms are present; AND
- Notify all at work close contacts during infectious period; AND
- Report to health agencies: Summit County Health, Medina County Health, ODJFS (Childcare Only)
- After 5 Days, do you have a Fever?
 - YES: Continue isolation until your fever is gone and other symptoms have improved;
 - NO: Return to work; Wear a face covering for the next 5 days.



EXPOSED and UNVACCINATED

If you are unvaccinated or your COVID-19 <u>vaccines are NOT up-to-date</u>, you must follow these precautions:

- Quarantine from work for 5 days after your last exposure; AND
- Test on day five after your last exposure (recommended); THEN
- After 5 Days, do you have symptoms or have you tested positive?
 - YES: Begin Isolation as described in Positive COVID-19;
 - NO: Return to work; Wear a face covering for the next 5 days.



EXPOSED and VACCINATED

If you were exposed to someone who has COVID-19 and your <u>vaccines are up-to-date</u> (or if you have had a recent positive case), you do not need to Isolate or Quarantine from work and must follow these precautions:

- Wear a face covering for 10 days after your last exposure; AND
- Test on day five after your last exposure (recommended); AND
- If you develop symptoms or test positive, Isolate from work.

KEY TERMS

- Isolation separates people sick with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.
- Quarantine separates and restricts people exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick.
- Confirmed case is when a test sample indicates a positive infection, even if the individual has no symptoms.
- **Probable** case is when an individual is experiencing one or more COVID-19 symptom(s) **AND** has had Close Contact with a COVID-19 positive person during their infectious period.
- Close Contact/Exposed is being within 6ft of an infected person for a total of 15+ minutes over a 24 hr period. (more info)
- Vaccinated (up-to-date) means:
 - o Received a booster dose of any COVID-19 vaccine in the past 6 months; OR
 - o Completed the primary series (2 shots) of a Phizer or Moderna vaccine less than 6 months ago; OR
 - Ocompleted the primary series (1 shot) of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine less than 2 months ago.
- Recent Positive individuals that tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days and have ended isolation.
- **Infectious Period** is 48 hours prior to onset of symptoms through 5 days after onset of symptoms. If no symptoms, then use the date the positive test sample was taken as the onset date.



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COVID-19 SYMPTOMS (more info)

People with COVID-19 have symptoms ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms typically appear 2-5 days after exposure to the virus. The following list of symptoms aid in identifying people who may have COVID-19:

One of These	Two of These	
New uncontrolled cough	Chills	Nausea or vomiting
Shortness of breath; Difficulty breathing	Fatigue	Diarrhea
New loss of taste or smell	Muscle or body aches	Congestion or runny nose
Fever 100 F or higher	New onset severe headache	Sore throat

VACCINATION INFORMATION

We encourage staff that wish to receive the COVID-19 vaccination do so; especially those working in child care programs. Vaccination will help protect you and those around you from getting COVID-19. Common side effects may be similar to COVID-19 but do not require Isolation or Quarantine if occurring within 3 days of a vaccine dose (more info). The YMCA encourages staff to work their normal schedules; however, we understand this may not be appropriate in all cases. Each staff person should coordinate their work schedule with their supervisor.

- Common Side Effects (more info): Pain or Swelling at injection Site, Fever, Chills, Tiredness, Headache
