## Thank you for your interest in the swimming programs at the Wadsworth YMCA!

We are now accepting requests for our School Age, Open Swim Programs for Summer 2024. This will serve as your formal request for the summer and once it has been received, you will be given an agreement to sign with the rental details. The rental arrangements will be complete once you receive a written confirmation form.

Please note that the majority of supervising adults must be in the water with the kids and others are asked to be attentively watching your group from the deck and supervising bathroom trips. A colored wristband system and swim tests are used for the safety of the swimmers. Please do not use Green or Yellow wrist bands to ID your group when traveling to the YMCA to swim.

Indoor or outdoor pool open swims may be reserved in advance by organized Day Care and Child Care programs – reservations are required and will be confirmed in writing. Available Times and Prices:

## Indoor Pool:

Safety Around Water (SAW) 30 min. swim lesson with 30 min open swim (7 classes). \$60 per student – due at first class. (Supervising adults will be in the water supervising students). OPEN SWIM: 60 min swim - Please call for availability – Space is limited. \$95 for up to 50 children, \$130 for 51-75 children per visit - due upon arrival. Adult staff free. Outdoor Pool: Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday mornings 9:15-10:45 am swim \$6 per child/Adult staff free (Outdoor Pool Swims are cancelled for poor weather), due upon arrival.
